

Nova's Seasonal Discovery

Learning objective: To identify and describe the key features of the four seasons and how they change the natural world.

Look at the questions below and help Nova the owl learn about how the seasons change. Write or draw your answers in the spaces provided.

Nova the owl is watching the world from her tree. She notices that the weather changes throughout the year. Sometimes it is hot and sunny, and sometimes it is cold and snowy. The plants and trees change too!

Word bank: Spring · Summer · Fall · Winter · Leaves · Snow · Flowers · Sun

1. Nova sees new flowers growing in the garden. Which season is it when new life begins to grow? (2 marks)

2. In which season do the leaves turn brown and fall off the trees? (2 marks)

3. When it is very cold and there might be snow on the ground, which season are we in? (2 marks)

4. Nova loves the hot sun! Which season is usually the warmest? (2 marks)

5. If you had £1 to spend on a treat for a picnic in the park, which season would be the best time to eat it outside? Why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a tree in your favorite season. Show what the weather looks like and what is happening to the tree.



Extension challenge: Go on a nature walk with an adult. Can you find one thing that shows it is the current season? Tell a friend what you found!
