

Rosa's Animal Fact-File: Mi Animal Favorito

Learning objective: To identify and describe animals in Spanish using noun-adjective agreement and simple sentence structures.

Help Rosa the parrot learn about the animal kingdom! Choose your favorite animal and complete this fact-file in Spanish. Use the word bank to help you describe what the animal looks like and where it lives. Remember to check if your adjectives match the gender of the noun (e.g., 'es grande' or 'es pequeño').

Word bank: grande (big) · pequeño (small) · rápido (fast) · lento (slow) · el león (lion) · el elefante (elephant) · el delfín (dolphin) · vive en la selva (lives in the jungle) · vive en el mar (lives in the sea) · es de color...

1. Nombre del animal: Write the name of your chosen animal in Spanish and draw it in your head. What is it called? (2 marks)

2. Descripción física: Use the word bank to describe the size and color of your animal. (e.g., El león es grande y amarillo.) (3 marks)

3. Hábitat: Where does this animal live? Use the phrase 'vive en...' to explain its home. (2 marks)

4. Movimiento: Is your animal fast or slow? Write a sentence about how it moves. (2 marks)

5. Opinión personal: Why do you like this animal? Write one sentence starting with 'Me gusta porque...' (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add a sentence about what your animal likes to eat? Use the phrase 'Come...' followed by a food item.
