

Rosa's Body Part Scramble

Learning objective: To identify and spell common body parts in Spanish and match them to the correct English translation.

Rosa the parrot has mixed up her labels! Look at the Spanish words in the word bank. Each word describes a part of the body. Draw a line from the Spanish word on the left to the correct English translation on the right to help Rosa tidy up her notes.

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · los ojos (eyes) · la nariz (nose) · la boca (mouth) · las manos (hands) · los pies (feet)

1. 1. Match 'la cabeza' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

2. 2. Match 'los ojos' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

3. 3. Match 'la nariz' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

4. 4. Match 'la boca' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

5. 5. Match 'las manos' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

6. 6. Match 'los pies' to the correct English meaning. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a funny self-portrait of yourself. Next to each body part (head, eyes, nose, _____ mouth, hands, feet), write the correct Spanish label from the word bank.

Extension challenge: Rosa the parrot wants to learn more! Can you find out how to say 'my arm' (el brazo) and 'my leg' (la pierna) in Spanish? Write a sentence including one of these new words, such as: 'Me duele el brazo' (My arm hurts).
