

Spanish Assessment: El Cuerpo (The Body)

Learning objective: To identify and describe parts of the human body in Spanish, demonstrating understanding of gender and singular/plural forms.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot is here to help you remember your vocabulary! Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is checking her health before flying to Spain. She says: '¡Hola! To stay fit, I brush my hair (el pelo), touch my nose (la nariz), and wiggle my toes on my feet (los pies). Using my wings (las alas) and my legs (las piernas), I am ready for an adventure!'

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · los ojos (eyes) · la nariz (nose) · la boca (mouth) · las orejas (ears) · los brazos (arms) · las manos (hands) · las piernas (legs) · los pies (feet) · el pelo (hair)

1. Translate these three body parts into Spanish. Remember to include the correct article (el/la/los/las): 1. The head, 2. The mouth, 3. The eyes. (3 marks)

2. If a word ends in a vowel, we usually add '-s' to make it plural. If it ends in a consonant, we add '-es'. Looking at your word bank, write the plural form of 'la nariz' (Hint: it ends in 'z', which changes to 'c' before adding '-es'). (2 marks)

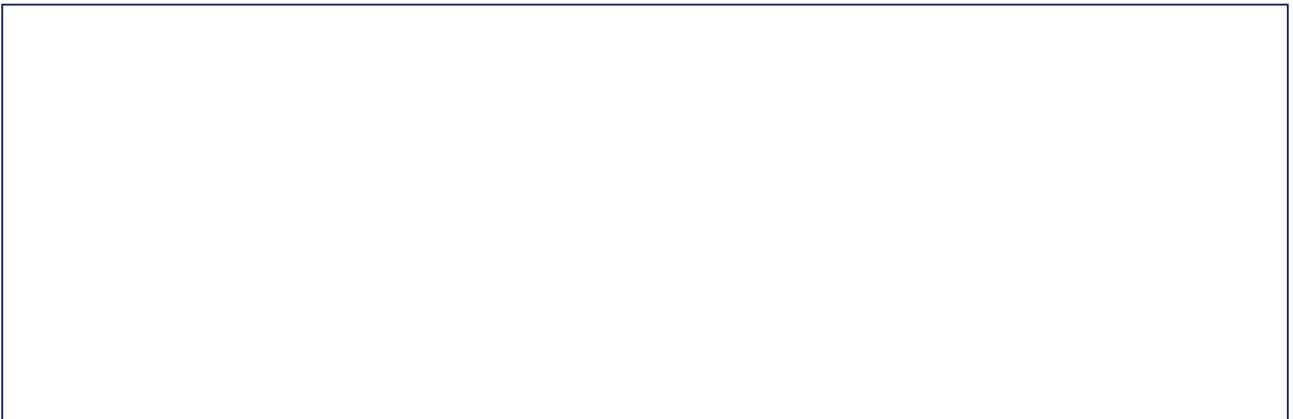
3. Explain why we use 'los' for 'ojos' but 'las' for 'orejas'. Think about the gender of the nouns. (3 marks)

4. Match the following descriptions to the correct body part: A) You use these to walk (plural). B) You use these to hold a pen (plural). C) You use this to smell (singular). (3 marks)

5. Rosa is describing a robot. Complete the sentences in Spanish: 'El robot tiene una cabeza grande. El robot tiene dos _____ (arms) y cuatro _____ (legs).' (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph in Spanish (5 sentences) describing your own body or a made-up monster. Include at least four body parts and use simple adjectives like 'grande' (big) or 'pequeño' (small). (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a 'Monster of the Week' and label five of its body parts using the correct Spanish vocabulary from your word bank.
