

Grade 3 Spanish Assessment: La Ropa (Clothes)

Learning objective: To identify, describe, and categorize items of clothing in Spanish, including understanding gender and number agreement.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank provided to help you with your spellings. Ensure you consider whether the item is masculine (el/un) or feminine (la/una) when writing your answers.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny day at the park. She decides to wear a red t-shirt, blue pants, and green shoes. Later, she spots a friend wearing a yellow hat and a smart skirt.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (pants) · la chaqueta (jacket) · el vestido (dress) · los zapatos (shoes) · el sombrero (hat) · la falda (skirt) · los calcetines (socks) · azul (blue) · rojo/a (red) · verde (green)

1. Using the passage, list the three items of clothing Rosa is wearing in Spanish. (3 marks)

2. Translate the following sentence into Spanish: 'The shoes are blue.' Remember to use the correct article and adjective agreement. (3 marks)

3. Identify which of these items are plural in Spanish: la chaqueta, los pantalones, el sombrero, los calcetines. (2 marks)

4. Explain why we use 'la' for 'falda' but 'el' for 'vestido'. How does the gender of the noun change how we describe the item? (4 marks)

5. Imagine you are packing a suitcase for a holiday. Write four sentences in Spanish describing what you are packing. Use a variety of clothing items and colors (e.g., 'Tengo una camiseta roja'). (8 marks)

6. If a store sold a jacket for £15 and a hat for £5, how would you write the total price in Spanish words? (Hint: Quince + Cinco). (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a character wearing a complete outfit. Label at least four items of clothing in Spanish, including the colors of each item.



Extension challenge: Compare and contrast clothing for summer and winter. Write a short paragraph in English explaining why Spanish vocabulary for clothes might be categorized by weather. What might happen if you used the wrong gendered article in a Spanish sentence? Justify why grammatical accuracy is important when communicating with others. Total: /25
