

Rosa's Spanish Wardrobe

Learning objective: To understand and recall vocabulary related to clothing in Spanish within a short descriptive text.

Read the text carefully and answer the questions below. Ensure you use the provided word bank to help you understand the Spanish terms.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny adventure in the park. She loves to choose her outfit carefully to match her colorful feathers. Today, she decides to wear her favorite bright red t-shirt, which is 'la camiseta roja'. Because it is a breezy day, she puts on her comfortable blue pants, known as 'los pantalones azules'. Rosa finds her smart brown shoes, 'los zapatos marrones', and ties them up tightly. Since she is going to be outside for a long time, she decides to bring her thick, warm coat, 'el abrigo', just in case the weather changes later in the afternoon. To finish her look, she places a stylish sun hat, 'el sombrero', on her head to protect her eyes. Rosa looks in the mirror and chirps happily. She is very proud of her new outfit and feels ready to greet all her friends. Whether it is cold or sunny, Rosa always knows exactly what to wear to stay comfortable while she practices her languages and explores the world.

1. Which two items of clothing does Rosa choose that are blue and red? (2 marks)

2. Why does Rosa decide to bring her 'el abrigo' (coat) with her? (2 marks)

3. How does Rosa feel about her outfit at the end of the text? (2 marks)

4. Why might Rosa have chosen to wear 'el sombrero' (the hat) for a day in the park? (2 marks)

5. If you were going to the park with Rosa, which item of clothing from the text would you choose to wear and why? (3 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing her full outfit described in the passage. Label each item of clothing using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are helping Rosa pack a suitcase for a holiday. Write a list of three more items of clothing you think she might need in Spanish, and explain where she might be going.
