

Los Días de la Semana: Rosa's Weekly Guide

Join Rosa the Parrot on a colorful journey through the Spanish week—practice saying them aloud!

- **Lunes, martes, miércoles, jueves, viernes** are the five school days in Spain.
- **Sábado and domingo** are the two days of the weekend (**el fin de semana**).
- To ask what day it is, say: '**¿Qué día es hoy?**'
- To answer the question, start your sentence with: '**Hoy es...**' (Today is...).
- Remember that '**miércoles**' is the only day of the week that needs an accent mark on the letter 'e'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the days of the week are not capitalised unless they appear at the very beginning of a sentence. Also, the Spanish week traditionally starts on a Monday (lunes), not a Sunday!

Key vocabulary: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday) · ¿Qué día es hoy? (What day is it today?)
