

Rosa's Spanish Weekly Calendar

Learning objective: To learn and recall the days of the week in Spanish and understand their order.

Read the story below about Rosa the parrot and her busy week. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions about her schedule.

Hola! I am Rosa. I love to teach my friends new words. My week is always very busy. On lunes, I practice my singing. On martes, I help Max count his mangoes. On miércoles, I read stories with Pip. By jueves, I am ready to help Kit solve computer puzzles. On viernes, I visit Nova to look at the stars. Then, on sábado and domingo, I fly to the park to paint colorful patterns with Zara. It is a wonderful week!

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday) · hoy (today) · mañana (tomorrow)

1. Which day of the week does Rosa practice her singing? (1 mark)

2. Rosa helps Max count mangoes on 'martes'. Based on the word bank, what is the English name for this day? (1 mark)

3. If today is lunes, what would you say in Spanish for tomorrow? (1 mark)

4. List the two days of the weekend in Spanish. (2 marks)

5. Rosa visits Nova on 'viernes'. Write a full sentence in English explaining what Rosa does on that day. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favorite day of the week. Label your drawing with the correct Spanish word for that day.



Extension challenge: Write a short diary entry for your own week using at least three Spanish days of the week correctly in your sentences.
