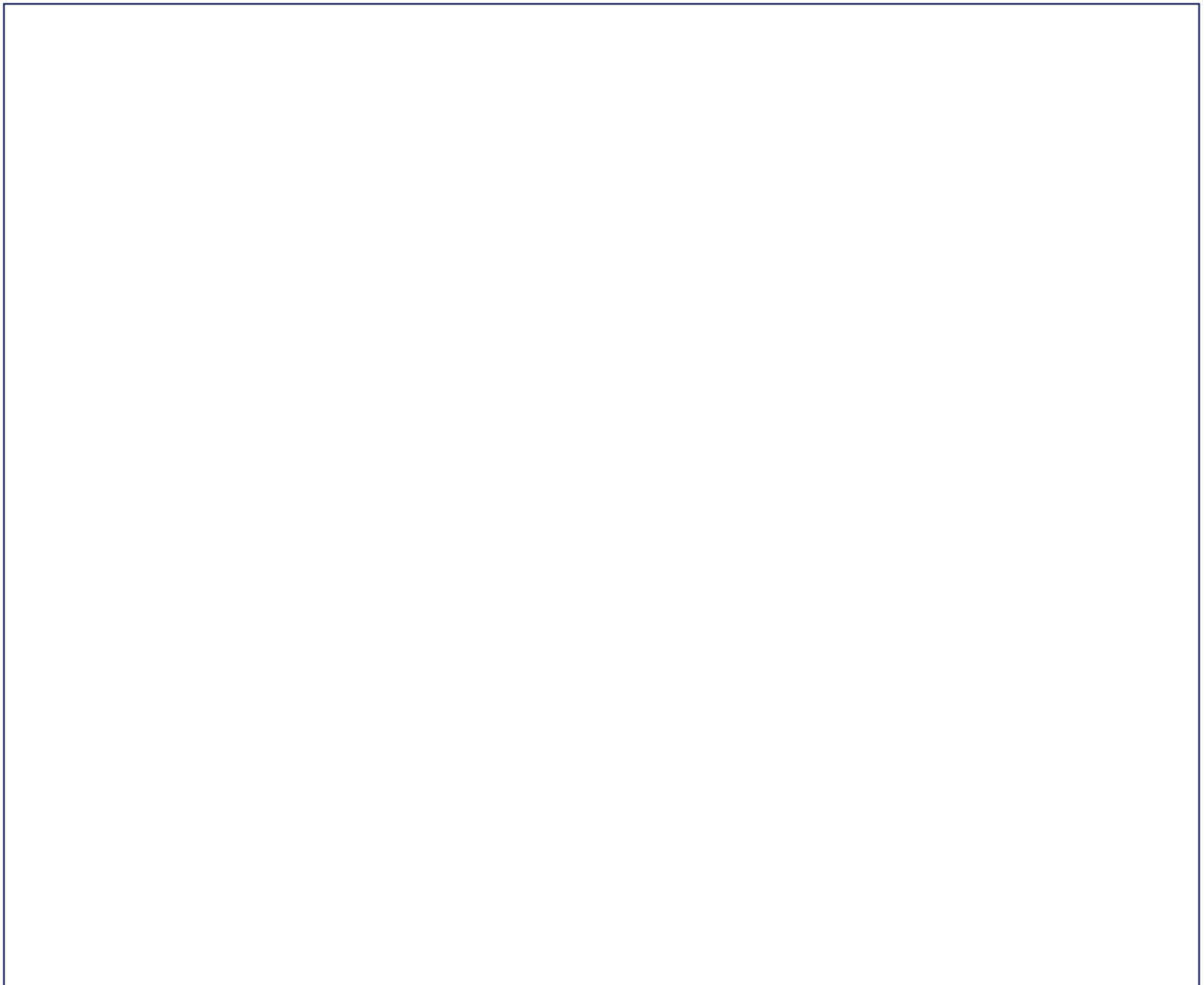


Rosa's Spanish Greeting Garden

Learning objective: To use and apply Spanish greetings and introductions in a creative context.

Help Rosa the parrot organize a garden party! Use the word bank to label your drawing and ensure every character is greeted correctly in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene featuring Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch. Below her, draw two characters meeting each other. Use speech bubbles to show them greeting one another. Include labels from the word bank pointing to the appropriate parts of your drawing (e.g., a clock showing morning time for '¡Buenos días!'). **Style:** Use bright, cheerful colors and clear, neat handwriting for your labels.



Label words: ¡Hola! · ¡Buenos días! · ¡Buenas tardes! · ¡Adiós! · ¿Cómo te llamas? · Me llamo...

Steps:

1. If Rosa meets a friend in the morning, which greeting from the word bank should she use? Write your answer here.
2. Translate the phrase 'Me llamo' into English.
3. You meet a new friend at the party. Write the Spanish question you would use to ask their name.
4. If you are leaving the party late in the afternoon, which greeting is most appropriate?
5. Draw a speech bubble coming from Rosa. Inside, write a short greeting to a friend named Leo.
