

Rosa's Hobbies Challenge

Learning objective: To learn and apply Spanish vocabulary related to hobbies and interests, and to express likes and dislikes using 'Me gusta' and 'No me gusta'.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends sort their hobbies! Look at the list of hobbies in the word bank. Match the Spanish phrases to the correct English meaning, then use the sentence builder to write sentences about what Rosa and her friends enjoy doing.

Word bank: Leer libros (Reading books) · Jugar al fútbol (Playing football) · Escuchar música (Listening to music) · Dibujar (Drawing/Art) · Nadar (Swimming) · Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like)

1. 1. Translate: 'Me gusta nadar.' (2 marks)

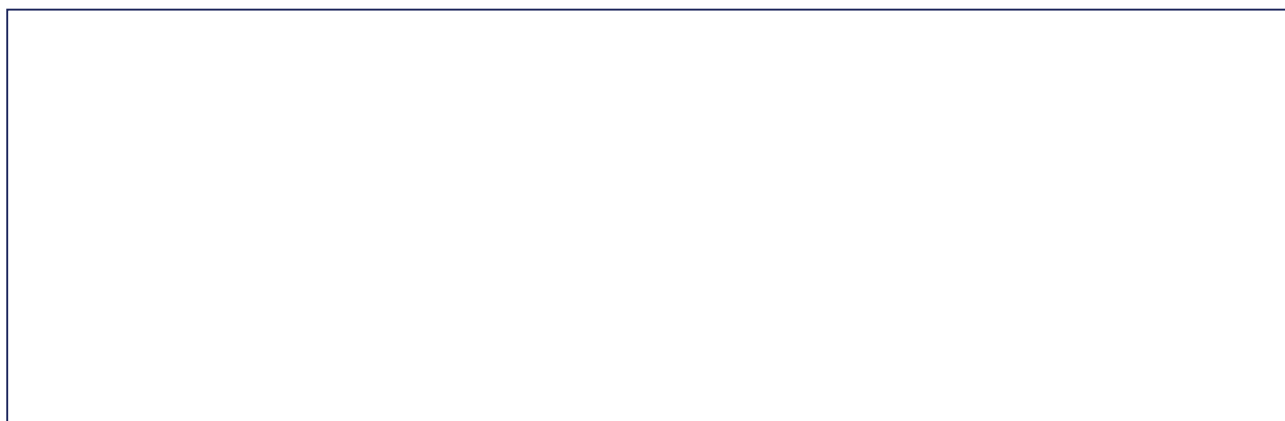
2. 2. If Max the monkey dislikes playing football, how would he say that in Spanish? (2 marks)

5. 5. Rosa loves reading. Write a Spanish sentence to say 'I like reading books'. (2 marks)
