

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Poll

Learning objective: To use Spanish opinion phrases (me gusta, no me gusta, me encanta) to express preferences about school subjects and hobbies.

Rosa the parrot is conducting a survey at the BookFlik Academy. Look at the icons next to each activity. If the icon is a happy face, write a sentence saying you love or like it. If the icon is a sad face, write a sentence saying you do not like it. Use the word bank to help you construct your sentences.

Word bank: Me gusta · No me gusta · Me encanta · el fútbol · el arte · la música · las matemáticas · la lectura · el chocolate

1. 1. [Happy Face] el fútbol (Use 'Me encanta') (2 marks)

2. 2. [Sad Face] las matemáticas (Use 'No me gusta') (2 marks)

3. 3. [Happy Face] la lectura (Use 'Me gusta') (2 marks)

4. 4. [Sad Face] el arte (Use 'No me gusta') (2 marks)

5. 5. [Happy Face] el chocolate (Use 'Me encanta') (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself doing your favorite hobby, and write one Spanish sentence underneath to describe how you feel about it using 'Me gusta' or 'Me encanta'.



Extension challenge: Interview a partner in class. Ask them '¿Te gusta el fútbol?' and record their answer in Spanish. If they say 'Sí', write their name under a 'Sí' column; if they say 'No', write it under a 'No' column.
