

De Compras con Rosa (Shopping with Rosa)

Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension skills in Spanish by identifying key vocabulary related to shops, prices, and quantities.

Read the passage about Rosa the parrot's trip to the market. Use your knowledge of Spanish vocabulary to answer the questions below. Remember to explain your thinking for the higher-order questions.

Hoy, Rosa la cotorra visita el mercado local. Ella quiere preparar una ensalada de frutas y comprar pan fresco. Primero, Rosa entra en la frutería. Ella compra dos kilos de manzanas rojas por £3.00. El frutero le dice: 'Las manzanas están muy baratas hoy'. Rosa está contenta porque le gusta ahorrar dinero. Después, ella camina hacia la panadería. El olor a pan recién horneado es delicioso. Rosa elige una barra de pan que cuesta £1.50. Ella paga con una moneda de £2.00 y recibe £0.50 de cambio. Rosa aprende que comprar en el mercado es divertido y práctico. Ella usa su lista de la compra para no olvidar nada. Al final del día, Rosa regresa a casa con su cesta llena de comida saludable. Mañana, ella quiere ir a la librería para comprar un libro sobre viajes, pero sabe que debe ahorrar sus monedas de nuevo.

1. Identify two items that Rosa buys at the market and state the price of each. (Literal) (2 marks)

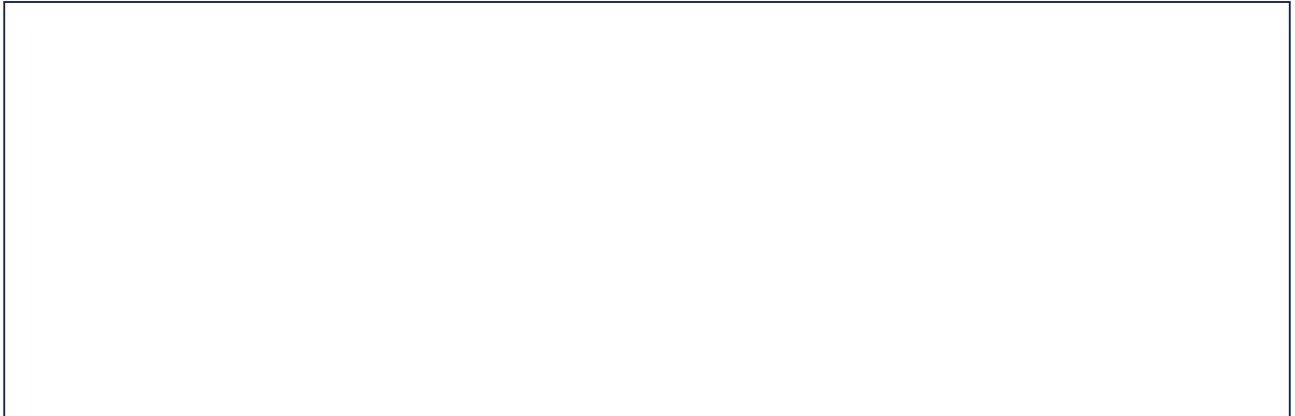
2. How much change does Rosa receive after buying the bread? Show your calculation. (Literal) (2 marks)

3. Explain why Rosa feels happy about the price of the apples. (Inferential) (2 marks)

4. What does the text suggest about Rosa's attitude towards money management? Support your answer with evidence. (Inferential) (3 marks)

5. Justify whether you think Rosa is a sensible shopper. Use evidence from the text to support your opinion. (Evaluative) (3 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot at the market holding a woven basket. Include a sign that says 'Fruta fresca' and show the apples and the bread she purchased.



Extension challenge: Imagine Rosa wants to buy a book that costs £5.00. If she already has £2.00, how many more pounds does she need? Write a short dialogue in Spanish between Rosa and the librarian, asking how much the book costs and expressing that she needs to save more money.
