

Rosa's Sports Club: Los Deportes

Learning objective: To learn and apply vocabulary related to sports in Spanish, including expressing likes and dislikes.

Welcome to the club! Rosa the parrot is ready to help you talk about your favorite activities. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions below.

Word bank: el fútbol (football) · el tenis (tennis) · la natación (swimming) · el baloncesto (basketball) · el ciclismo (cycling) · Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · ¿Qué deporte te gusta? (What sport do you like?)

1. Rosa is asking you, '¿Qué deporte te gusta?' Write a full sentence in Spanish to tell her which sport you like. Use the structure: 'Me gusta...' (2 marks)

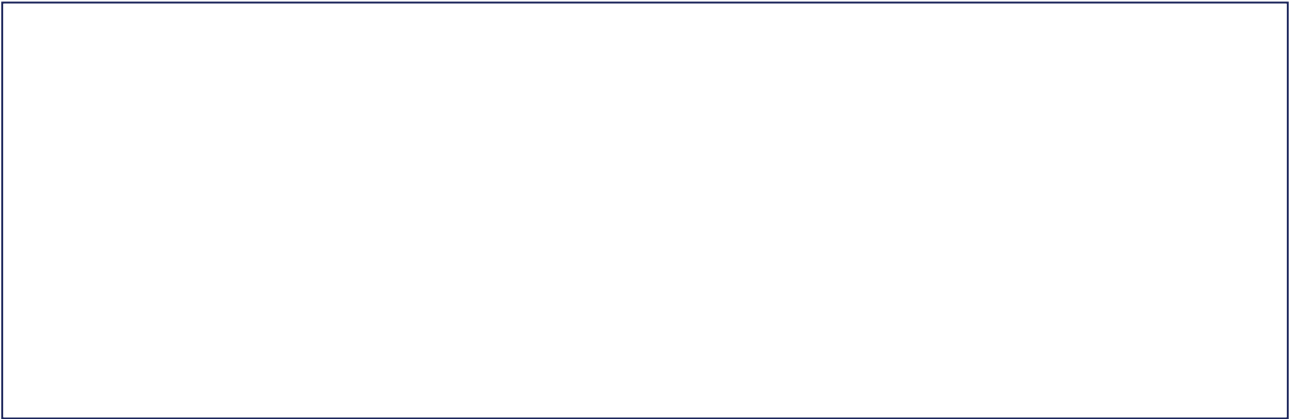
2. Translate these two sentences into English: 1) Me gusta el fútbol. 2) No me gusta el ciclismo. (2 marks)

3. Max the monkey wants to play a team sport that uses a ball and a hoop. Which sport from the word bank should he choose? (1 mark)

4. If Finn the dolphin goes to the ocean to exercise, which sport from the word bank is he most likely doing? (1 mark)

5. Write a question in Spanish to ask a friend which sport they like. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself playing your favorite sport. Label your drawing with the Spanish name of the sport (e.g., 'el tenis').



Extension challenge: Research one other sport in Spanish that is not in the word bank and write a sentence explaining why you would like to try it!
