

Rosa's Spanish Clock Store

Learning objective: To tell the time in Spanish using o'clock, half past, and quarter past/to.

Rosa the parrot is opening her clock store! Help her label the clocks by drawing the correct hands and writing the Spanish time underneath each one. Follow the steps to complete your masterpiece.

Draw: Draw a large, colorful store wall featuring four distinct circular clocks. Use a bright, cheerful art style. Around the store, draw Rosa the parrot wearing a small scarf, holding a paintbrush. Ensure the clock faces are large enough to clearly draw hour and minute hands. Add decorative patterns around the border of each clock to match the style of Zara the zebra's favorite art pieces.



Label words: Es la una · Son las dos · y cuarto · y media · menos cuarto · en punto

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a clock showing 1:00. Label it in Spanish using 'Es la una en punto'.
2. Step 2: Draw a clock showing 3:15. Label it in Spanish using 'Son las tres y cuarto'.
3. Step 3: Draw a clock showing 6:30. Label it in Spanish using 'Son las seis y media'.
4. Step 4: Draw a clock showing 9:45. Label it in Spanish using 'Son las diez menos cuarto'.
5. Explain why we say 'Es la una' instead of 'Son las una'.
