

¡Vamos! Transport in Spanish

Join Rosa the Parrot on a journey across the globe! How do you travel to school today?

- To say you are traveling by train, use the phrase 'Voy en tren'.
- If you are riding your bicycle, you can say 'Voy en bicicleta'.
- To talk about a journey by car, use the phrase 'Voy en coche'.
- Remember that 'el avión' is the Spanish word for aeroplane.
- If you are traveling by boat, you say 'Voy en barco'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, when talking about traveling by a specific mode of transport, we often use the word 'en'. For example, 'Voy en autobús' means 'I go by bus'. However, if you are walking, you say 'Voy a pie'!
