

Rosa's Transport Travel Journal

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary related to transport and travel.

Help Rosa the parrot plan her trip across the world! Choose different types of transport to complete your travel journal. Use the Spanish vocabulary provided in the word bank to describe how you are traveling and where you are going. You can use a dictionary if you need to find extra adjectives to describe your journey.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el autobús (bus) · el tren (train) · el avión (plane) · el barco (boat) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · rápido (fast) · lento (slow) · grande (big) · pequeño (small)

1. Destination and Transport: Write down where you are going and which mode of transport you are choosing. Use a full sentence in Spanish, e.g., 'Voy a Madrid en el tren.' (2 marks)

2. Describing the Journey: Describe your transport using the adjectives from the word bank. Is it fast or slow? Is it big or small? Write your answer in Spanish. (2 marks)

3. Reasoning: Why did you choose this type of transport? Explain your choice in English, thinking about the distance or the destination. (2 marks)

4. Ticket Price: Imagine your journey costs money. If a ticket is £12.50 and you buy tickets for 4 people, what is the total cost in pounds (£)? Show your calculation. (3 marks)

5. Personal Reflection: If you could travel anywhere in the world using any form of transport, where would you go and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a short dialogue between two people at a station or airport using at least three of your new Spanish transport words.
