

Sheet 4: The Unvoiced 'th' Sound

Worked example:

Say the sound and trace the word: t-h-i-n

Answer: thin

- **Pip the caterpillar is reading these words. Read them out loud:**

thin thick with both path bath

- **Complete the words using 'th':**

__in __ick wi__ bo__

- **Draw a line to match the word to the picture description:**

thin: a very slim stick thick: a big fat book bath: where you wash path: a walk in the woods

- **Write the word 'with' to finish the sentence: Pip goes to the park ____ Max.**

- **Circle the words that have the 'th' sound:**

thin dog thick cat both bath

Self-check: Check your words: do they all start or end with the quiet 'th' sound?
