

Sheet 13: Full Stops

Worked example:

Look at how Pip the caterpillar finishes his sentence: Pip eats a leaf.

Answer: Pip eats a leaf.

- **Trace the full stops at the end of these sentences.**

Max likes math. Nova looks at the moon.

- **Add a full stop to finish these sentences about Ellie the elephant.**

Ellie loves to read She has a big trunk

- **Write a full stop at the end of each sentence about Zara the zebra.**

Zara paints a picture She likes bright colors

- **Read these sentences. Circle the full stop at the end of each one.**

Finn swims in the sea. Leo writes a poem.

- **Write your own sentence about Bea the bee and remember to add a full stop.**

Bea flies to a flower
