

Sheet 11: Adding 2-digit numbers

Worked example:

Max says: To add $24 + 13$, first add the ones ($4 + 3 = 7$), then add the tens ($20 + 10 = 30$). $30 + 7 = 37$.

Answer: $24 + 13 = 37$

- Max has 22 shiny pebbles and finds 15 more. How many does he have now?

$$22 + 15 =$$

- Solve these additions:

$$31 + 12 = 44 + 23 =$$

- Add the tens and the ones to find the total:

$$50 + 20 = 61 + 16 =$$

- Max went to the store. He spent £25 on a book and £14 on a pen. How much did he spend in total?

$$£25 + £14 =$$

Self-check: Check your answers by adding the ones column first, then the tens column, to make sure your total matches.

Ready for next: Once you can add two 2-digit numbers confidently, you are ready to learn how to subtract 2-digit numbers from each other!
