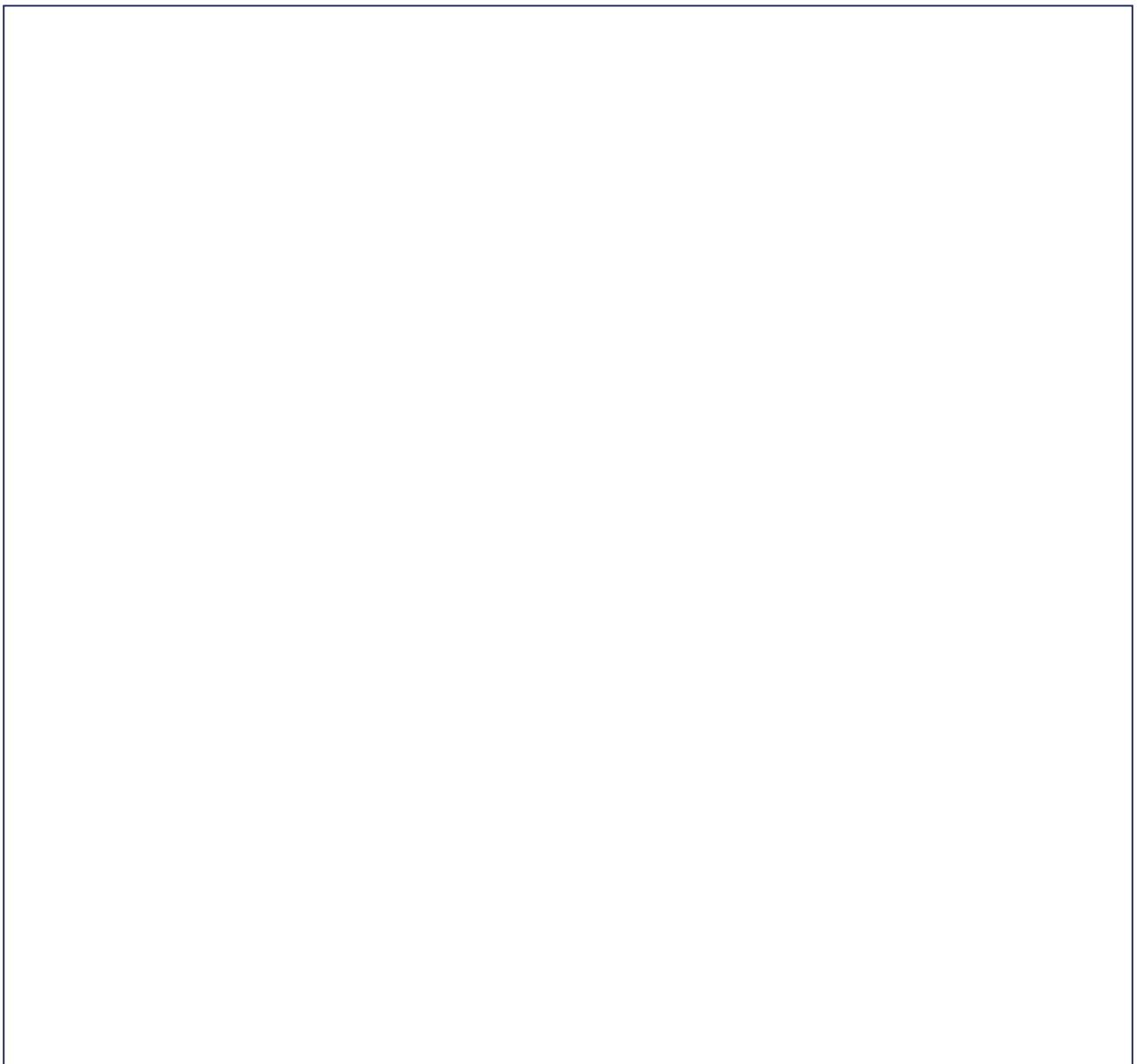


Zara's Creative Collage Corner

Learning objective: To explore the art of collage by identifying different textures and materials to decorate a picture.

Zara the Zebra loves to make art using bits and pieces she finds! Look at the picture below. You can colour it in, or try 'collage' by sticking small pieces of paper, fabric, or leaves onto the shapes to make them look textured.

Colour this: A large, bold outline drawing of Zara the Zebra standing in a garden. Zara is holding a glue stick in her hoof. Next to her is a table with a basket full of shapes: circles, squares, and triangles. In the background, there is a big, simple sun with smiling rays and a large, empty flower shape waiting to be decorated. The lines should be thick and clear, perfect for children to colour or glue collage materials onto.



Steps:

1. Label the zebra in your picture.
2. Label the sun in your picture.
