- A collage is made by sticking many different pieces of paper or fabric onto one background.
- You can find collage materials all around you, like old magazines, leaves, or scraps of ribbon.
- Layering means putting one piece on top of another to hide or show parts of your picture.
- Using different textures, like bumpy cardboard or smooth tissue paper, makes your art feel special.
- When we make a collage, we can use glue sticks or PVA glue to hold our creations in place.
- There is no wrong way to make a collage; it is all about your own wonderful ideas!

Did you know? Did you know? The word 'collage' comes from a French word that means 'to glue'! Zara the Zebra loves making collages by collecting bits of shiny foil, soft fabric, and rough sandpaper to make her pictures feel as interesting as they look.
