

Collage Fun with Zara the Zebra

Learning objective: To identify and understand key terms used when creating collages.

Read each card to learn about collage. Use the word bank to help you understand the terms. Ask a partner to test you!

What is a collage?

A collage is an artwork made by sticking different materials onto a surface.

What is texture?

Texture is how a surface feels, like bumpy, smooth, or soft.

What does layering mean?

Layering is placing pieces on top of each other to create depth.

What is composition?

Composition is where you choose to place your items on the page.

What does overlap mean?

Overlap is when one piece covers part of another piece.

Name three materials you can use for a collage.

Paper, fabric, and leaves.

What is a background?

The background is the base layer at the very back of your collage.

Why do we use glue?

We use glue to keep all our collage pieces in their place.

What is Zara's favourite art style?

Zara loves collage because she can mix different colours and patterns.

Can you use recycled items in a collage?

Yes! You can use old magazines, card, or buttons.
