

Zara's Collage Creator: My Art Plan

Learning objective: To plan and design a collage using a variety of textures and materials.

Hello! I am Zara the zebra. I love finding patterns in everything I see. Today, you are going to plan your own collage. A collage is a piece of art made by sticking different materials onto a background. Use this sheet to plan your work. Think about the colours and textures you will use. Remember to list your materials and describe how you will stick them down.

Word bank: texture · collage · materials · pattern · layer · background · glue · overlap

1. My Collage Idea: What will be the main picture in your collage? (e.g., a forest, a space scene, or a pattern) (2 marks)

2. Materials List: What items will you use? (e.g., tissue paper, wool, shiny foil, or old magazines) (2 marks)

3. Texture Plan: Which materials will feel rough or smooth? How will they look together? (2 marks)

4. Step-by-Step: What is the first thing you will stick on? What will go on top? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Find three different items at home or in class that have an interesting texture. Draw them in your sketchbook and describe how they feel: rough, smooth, soft, or bumpy.
