

Zara's Colour Explorer Diary

Learning objective: To identify primary colours and explore how they mix to create secondary colours through creative observation.

Help Zara the zebra find colours in the world around you! Use this diary to record your discoveries. Find objects that match the primary colours and then experiment with mixing paint to see what new colours you can create. Remember to use your best handwriting or ask a grown-up to help you scribe your observations.

1. My Primary Discovery: Find something red, yellow, or blue in your classroom or home. What did you find?

2. Mixing Magic: If you mix red and yellow paint together, what colour do you make? Describe it.

3. Blue and Yellow: What happens when you mix blue and yellow paint? Tell me what you see.

4. My Favourite Colour: Which colour makes you feel the happiest? Why do you like this colour?

5. Zara's Pattern Challenge: Can you spot a pattern today? Describe the colours you see in the pattern.

Extension challenge: Can you go on a colour hunt outside and find a natural object for every colour of the rainbow? Share your findings with a friend!
