

Zara the Zebra's Colourful Art Adventure

Learning objective: To understand the colour wheel, including primary and secondary colours.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the colours. Follow the steps to show what you know about mixing colours.

Word bank: Primary · Secondary · Red · Yellow · Blue · Green · Orange · Purple

1. Zara the Zebra wants to paint a picture. Name the three primary colours that she needs to start with. (3 marks)

2. If you mix Red and Yellow together, which colour do you make? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Red and Yellow, I make... (1 mark)

3. Which colour is made by mixing Blue and Yellow? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Blue and Yellow, I make... (1 mark)

4. Which colour is made by mixing Blue and Red? Start your sentence like this: When I mix Blue and Red, I make... (1 mark)

5. Are Green, Orange, and Purple called primary or secondary colours? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a simple circle divided into six parts. Colour the sections using the primary colours (Red, Yellow, Blue) and the secondary colours (Green, Orange, Purple) in the correct order around the circle.



Extension challenge: Zara wants to paint a sunset. Which colours would you choose to make it look warm? Write down two colours and explain why.
