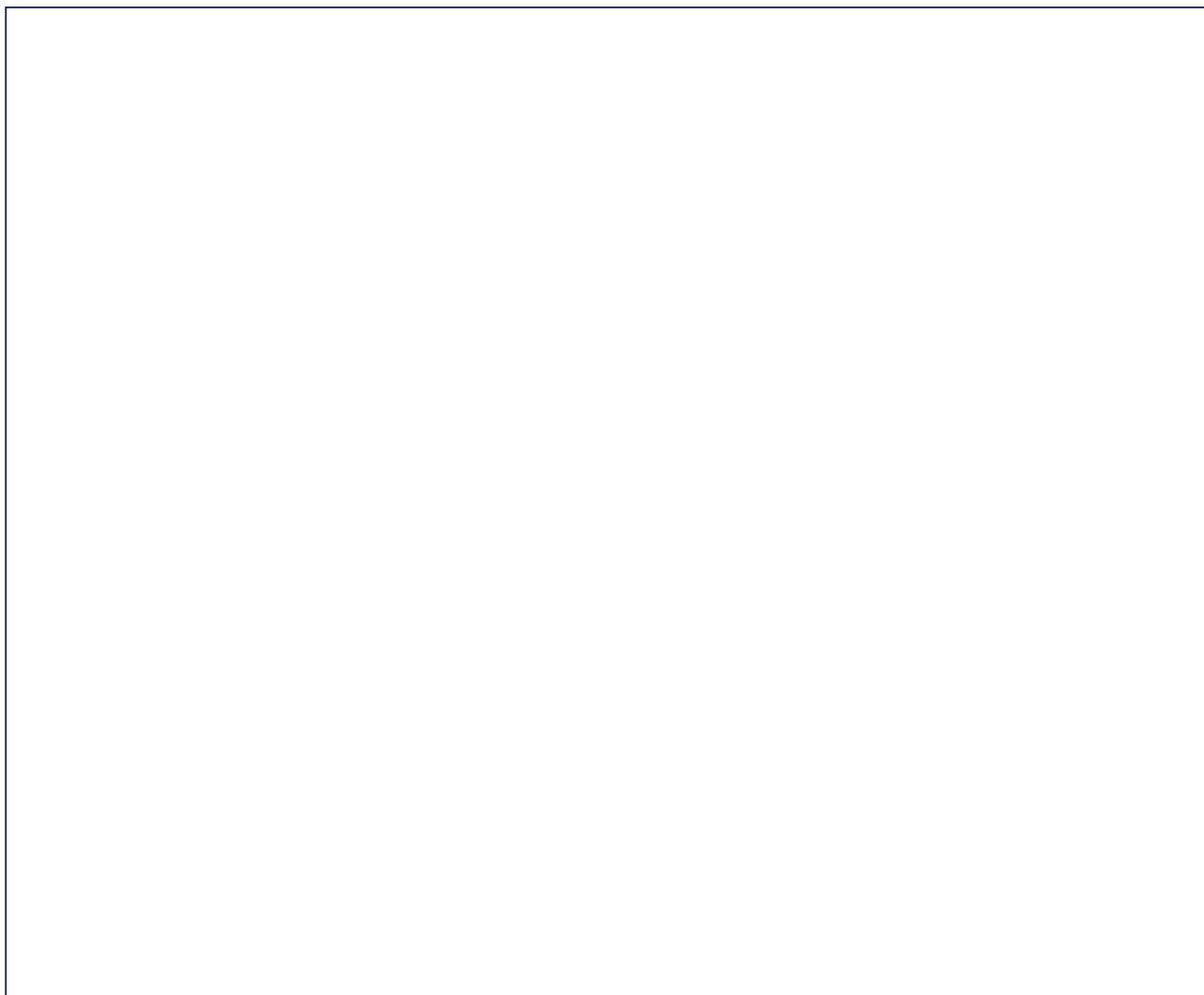


Zara's Wonderful Landscapes

Learning objective: To observe and represent the natural world by drawing a landscape, using different shapes and colours to show elements of the environment.

Today, we are going to draw a beautiful landscape with Zara the zebra! A landscape is a picture of the land outside. Think about what you see when you look out of a window or go to the park. Follow the steps below to create your own scene.

Draw: Create a landscape scene on the blank space provided. Start by drawing a horizon line. Include a bright sun in the sky, at least one tree, and rolling hills. Use bright colours to show the different parts of nature. Zara suggests adding patterns to your tree leaves or flowers to make your art unique.



Label words: sky · sun · hills · tree · grass · cloud

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a wavy line across the middle of your page to make some hills. What colour will you colour your grass?
2. Step 2: Draw a big, yellow circle in the corner of your sky. What is this shape in the sky called?
3. Step 3: Draw a tall, brown shape to be a tree trunk. How many branches will your tree have?
4. Step 4: Use your pencil to label your drawing using the words in the word bank.

5. Step 5: Zara loves patterns! Can you draw some small flowers on your grass using circles or dots?
