

Zara's Landscape Artist Diary

Learning objective: To describe a landscape using accurate vocabulary and explain the artistic choices made.

Zara the zebra wants to see your art! Follow these steps to complete your landscape diary:

1. Look at your drawing of a landscape.
2. Use the boxes below to describe what you see.
3. Use the word bank to help you write your sentences.
4. Write neatly in the lines provided.

Word bank: foreground · background · horizon · vibrant · texture · landscape · colour · shades · natural

1. What is the main subject of your landscape? (e.g., Is it a forest, a beach, or a mountain?) (2 marks)

2. What can you see in the foreground (the part closest to you)? (2 marks)

3. What colours did you use for the sky or the background? (2 marks)

4. Which part of your landscape are you most proud of and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to add one more detail to your drawing, like a small animal or a tree, to make your landscape feel alive!
