

Zara's Sculpture Studio

Learning objective: To understand that sculptures are 3D objects and to identify different materials used to create them.

Zara the zebra loves to make art! A sculpture is a 3D object that you can walk around. Look at the list of materials below. Decide if each material is hard or soft. Then, write a sentence to explain what you would make with it.
