

Zara's Sculpture Studio: My Planning Sheet

Learning objective: To plan and describe a sculpture using artistic vocabulary, understanding how materials can be joined and shaped.

Hello! I am Zara the zebra. I love to find patterns and shapes everywhere I look. Today, you are going to be a sculptor. Use this sheet to plan your own 3D art piece. Think about what your sculpture will be made of and how it will stand up. Follow the prompts below to describe your creation.

Word bank: sculpture · texture · materials · clay · cardboard · join · shape · smooth · rough · structure

1. What is the name of your sculpture and what will it look like? (Hint: Think about the shapes you will use.) (2 marks)

2. Which materials will you use to make your sculpture? (e.g., clay, card, foil, or wood) (2 marks)

3. How will you join the parts of your sculpture together so it stays in one piece? (2 marks)

4. What words describe the texture of your sculpture? Will it be smooth, rough, soft, or bumpy? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you want to sell your sculpture in a gallery for £5.00. If a friend buys it and pays with a £10.00 note, how much change should you give them?
