

Zara's Sculpture Workshop

Learning objective: To learn what a sculpture is and explore different ways to make 3D art.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Zara the zebra is here to help you think about shapes and textures!

Word bank: Sculpture · 3D · Clay · Texture · Form · Stone

1. Zara says that a sculpture is a piece of art that has three dimensions. What does '3D' mean? (Hint: Think about if you can walk around it.) (2 marks)

2. Name one material an artist might use to carve or build a sculpture. (1 mark)

3. If you touch a sculpture, how it feels is called its _____. Use a word from the word bank to fill in the gap. (1 mark)

4. Look at a chair in your classroom. Is a chair a sculpture? Explain why or why not. (2 marks)

Draw: Zara wants to build a sculpture of a fruit bowl. Draw a 3D bowl with an apple and a banana inside it. Use lines to show how the shapes are rounded.
