

Zara's Magical Watercolour Garden

Learning objective: To explore the properties of watercolours and develop fine motor skills through controlled colouring.

Use your watercolour paints to bring Zara the zebra's garden to life! Remember to use just a little bit of water to make your colours bright and see how they blend together on the paper.

Colour this: A large, friendly outline drawing of Zara the zebra standing in a garden. Zara is holding a paintbrush in her hoof. In front of her is a wooden easel with a canvas showing a simple rainbow. Around her are large, bold outlines of three big flowers with thick petals and two fluffy clouds in the sky. The lines should be thick and clear for young children to colour within. Include a small paint palette next to her with circular wells for paint.
