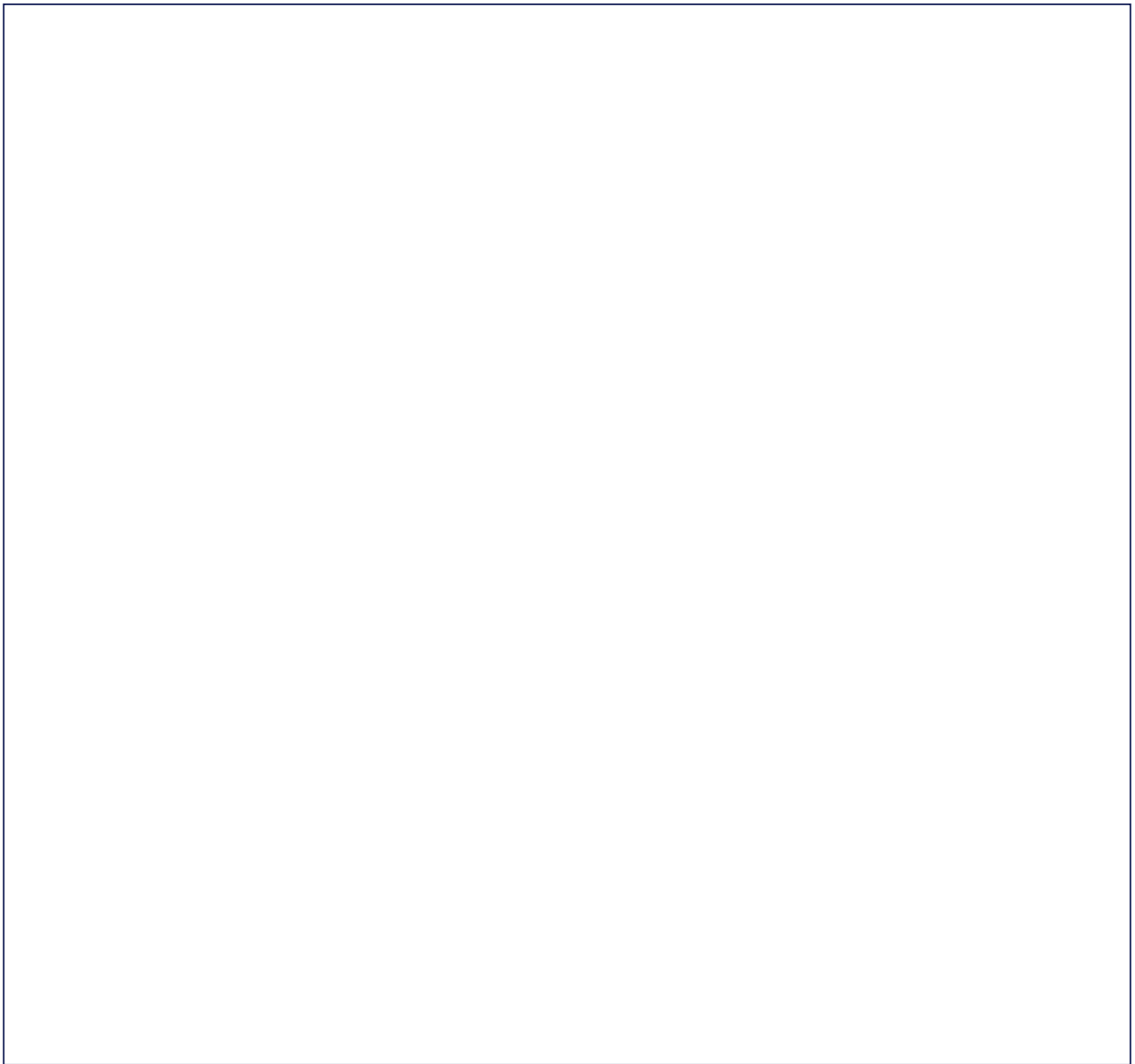


World Book Day Adventure with Pip

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and engage with the theme of reading for pleasure.

Use your favourite colouring pencils or crayons to bring Pip the bookworm's library to life. Think about what colours make a story feel exciting or calm!
