- Strong passwords should be at least 12 characters long and include a mix of uppercase letters, lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols to keep accounts safe.
- Never share your personal details, such as your home address, school name, or passwords, with anyone you do not know in real life.
- Phishing is when someone tries to trick you into clicking a fake link or downloading a file to steal your sensitive data.
- Two-factor authentication adds an extra layer of security by requiring a second code from your phone or email to log in.
- If you ever see something online that makes you feel worried, sad, or uncomfortable, tell a trusted adult immediately.
