**1. The Password Challenge: Kit needs a strong, secure password for his account. Write down three rules for creating a password that is hard for others to guess. (3 marks)**

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**2. Spotting Phishing: You receive an email from an unknown sender asking for your home address and school name. Explain why this is a risk and what actions you should take. (3 marks)**

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**3. Personal Information: List three pieces of information that you should never share with someone you have only met online, and explain why. (3 marks)**

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**4. Privacy Settings: Why is it important to regularly check the privacy settings on websites or apps you use? Describe what a privacy setting actually does. (2 marks)**

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**5. The 'Trusted Adult' Plan:** If you see something online that makes you feel worried or uncomfortable, what are the steps you should take? Name a trusted adult you could talk to. (2 marks)
