

Bonfire Night Adventure with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to label a scene and create an illustrative drawing based on Bonfire Night.

Leo the Lion is getting ready for a chilly Bonfire Night. Help him finish his picture by drawing the scene and labelling the parts. Follow the steps below to complete your work.

Draw: Draw a nighttime scene on a piece of A4 paper. In the centre, draw a big, crackling bonfire. Place Leo the Lion to the left, wearing a colourful woolly hat. In the dark sky above, draw a star-shaped firework with bright colours. Give Leo a glowing sparkler to hold in his hand. Use bright colours for the fire and dark blues or blacks for the night sky.



Label words: sparkler · bonfire · night sky · glow · firework · woolly hat

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large bonfire in the middle of your page. Draw Leo the Lion standing next to it wearing a warm woolly hat. Label the bonfire and the hat.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright firework bursting in the night sky above Leo. Label the firework.
3. Step 3: Draw a small, bright sparkler in Leo's paw. Label the sparkler.
4. Step 4: Use a yellow or orange crayon to add a glow around the fire. Label the glow.
