Read the front of each card. Think about the answer. Then, look at the back of the card to see if you are right. Use the word bank to help you understand the terms.

What is the name of the book?	Who wrote the story?
Title	Author
Who is the book about?	What happens in the story?
Character	Plot
What did you think of the story?	How many stars would you give the book?
Opinion	Rating
Should other people read this book?	A sentence about why you liked the book.
Recommendation	Reason
A word to describe the book, like 'funny' or 'scary'.	A short summary of the story without spoilers.
Adjective	Blurb
Max the monkey wants to know: what is the first thing you write in a review?	What do we call the main person in the story?
Title	Protagonist
