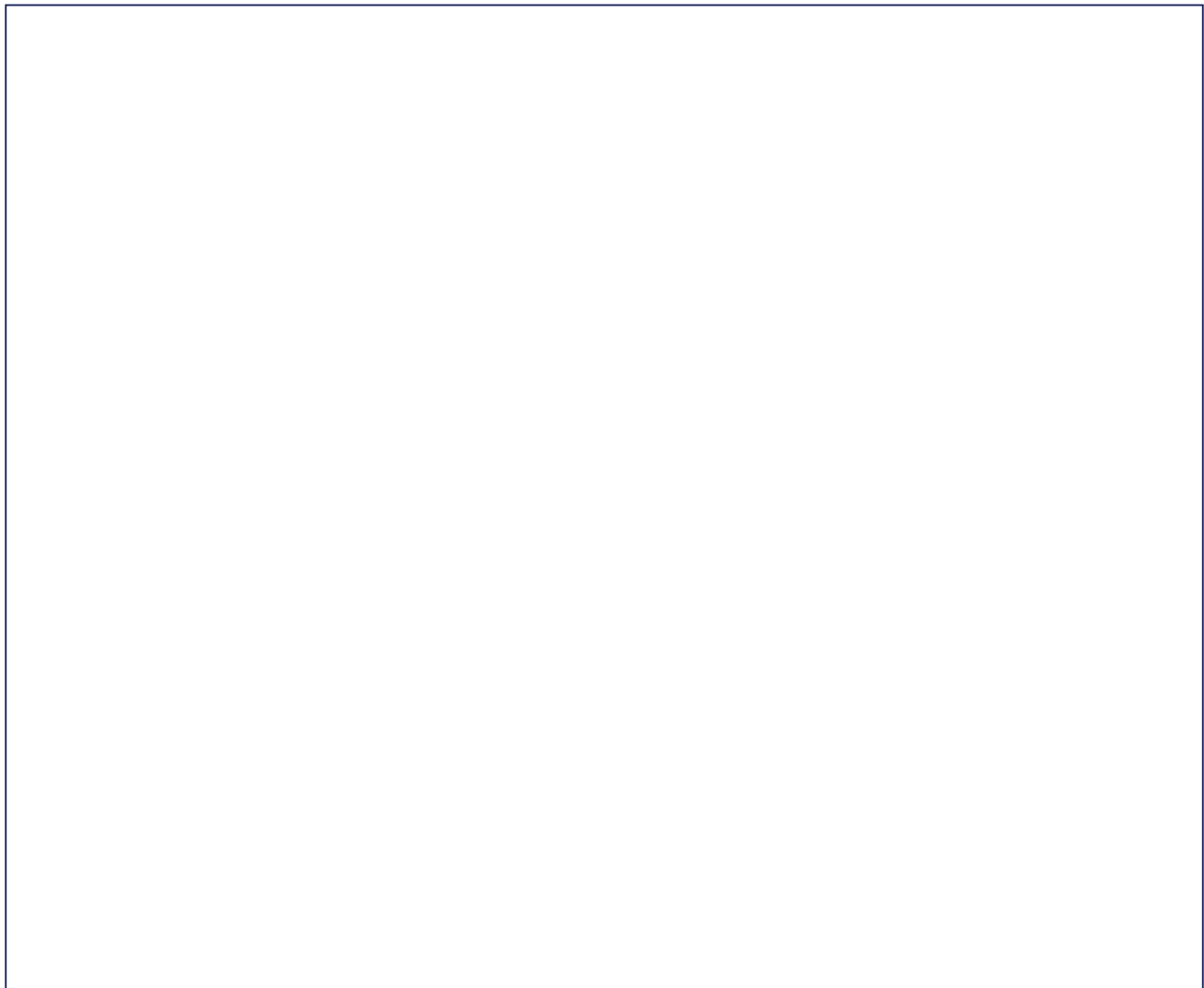


Max's Magical Maths Market

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and labels to plan a creative writing setting.

Follow the steps below to draw Max the monkey's market stall. Use your imagination to make it colourful. Add labels to your drawing using the word bank to help you describe the scene.

Draw: Draw a large market stall in the centre of the page. Include Max the monkey smiling behind the counter. Fill the counter with baskets of fruit. Use bright colours to show the market is busy and fun. Add labels with arrows pointing to the fruit and the stall to describe how they look.



Label words: shiny · bright · bunch · wooden · busy · fresh · golden · tasty

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Max standing behind a wooden stall. What is he holding? Draw it in his hand.
2. Step 2: Label one item on the stall using an adjective from the word bank (e.g., 'shiny apples').
3. Step 3: Draw a price tag on a bunch of fruit. Write a price in Australian dollars and cents (e.g., £1.50).
4. Step 4: Draw a background for the market. Is it a sunny day or a rainy day?
