

Year 4 Grammar Assessment: The Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use nouns, adjectives, verbs, and fronted adverbials correctly.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you get stuck. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Max the monkey sat in the garden. He saw a big, red apple on the tree. Quickly, he climbed up to reach it. The juicy fruit tasted sweet.

Word bank: Noun · Adjective · Verb · Adverb · Fronted Adverbial · Comma · Sentence

1. Find one noun from the passage. A noun is a person, place, or thing. (2 marks)

2. Find one adjective in the passage. An adjective describes a noun. (2 marks)

3. Find one verb in the passage. A verb is an action word. (2 marks)

4. Copy the fronted adverbial from the passage. Remember to include the comma. (4 marks)

5. Write a short story (3-4 sentences) about Pip the caterpillar eating a leaf. Use one adjective and one adverb. (15 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey in the garden holding his red apple.
