

Poetry Power Flashcards with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To identify and understand key poetic devices and features used in Year 4 poetry.

Read the front of the card. Try to guess what it means. Then, look at the answer after the line to check your learning! Use the word bank to help you.

What is a stanza?

A group of lines in a poem, like a paragraph.

What is alliteration?

When words close together start with the same sound.

What is a simile?

Comparing two things using the words 'like' or 'as'.

What is onomatopoeia?

A word that sounds like the noise it describes, like 'buzz'.

What is rhyme?

When words end with the same sound, like 'cat' and 'hat'.

What is personification?

Giving human qualities to an object or animal.

What is rhythm?

The beat or pattern of sounds in a poem.

What is imagery?

Using words to create a clear picture in the reader's mind.

What is a verse?

Another word used to describe a single line or a stanza of poetry.
