

Pip the Bookworm's Magical Library

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to visualise a setting and show understanding of a character's environment.

Read the instructions below to help Pip the Bookworm organise his library. Draw your ideas in the space provided. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a scene inside a giant oak tree library. **Style:** Use warm, inviting colours like golden yellow, forest green, and brown. Include a tiny desk made of a leaf, a stack of books, and a glowing lantern. Ensure Pip the caterpillar is visible, perhaps looking at an open book. Use clear lines for labels.



Label words: bookshelf · cozy · caterpillar · glowing · lantern · adventure · story

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Pip sitting at his leaf desk. What is he doing? (1 mark)
2. Step 2: Draw the soft mossy chair. How does it look? (1 mark)
3. Step 3: Label the golden lantern and the bookshelf in your picture. (1 mark)
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about what Pip is reading. (1 mark)
