

Reading Detective Flashcards with Max and Pip

Learning objective: To understand key reading comprehension terms to help find information in a text.

Read the front of the card to see the word. Turn it over to find the meaning. Use the word bank to help you understand the definitions.

Fact

A statement that is true and can be proven, like 'The sun is a star'.

Opinion

What someone feels or thinks, like 'Blue is the best colour'.

Inference

Using clues from the text and what you already know to work something out.

Prediction

A smart guess about what might happen next in the story.

Summary

A short paragraph that tells the main points of the story.

Character

A person or animal in a story, like Pip or Max.

Setting

Where and when the story takes place.

Plot

The main events that happen in a story from start to finish.

Evidence

Proof from the text that shows why your answer is correct.

Retrieval

Finding specific information written clearly in the text.

Author

The person who wrote the book or story.

Non-fiction

A book that is about real things, people, or events.
