

Max the Monkey's Market Trip

Learning objective: To retrieve information from a text and answer questions using complete sentences.

Read the short story about Max. Then, use the word bank to help you answer the questions below. Remember to start your sentences with a capital letter.

Max the monkey went to the local market on Saturday. He wanted to buy a snack. He saw a stall full of bright yellow bananas and shiny red apples. Max chose a bunch of bananas. The farmer told him the price was four pounds. Max handed over his money and walked home feeling very happy with his snack.

1. Who went to the market? (2 marks)

2. What two types of food did Max see at the stall? (2 marks)

3. Which fruit did Max choose to buy? (2 marks)

4. How much did the bananas cost in pounds? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Write one sentence about what you would buy if you went to the market with four pounds.
