Learning objective: To answer questions about a short story using evidence from the text.

Read the story opening below. Look at the word bank to help you write your answers. Use the sentence starters to help you finish each answer. Write clearly on the lines provided.

1. Where did Max climb? Use the text to help you: Max climbed to... (2 marks)

4. How might Max feel at the top of the tree? Sentence starter: Max might feel... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add one sentence to the story to explain what Max sees from the top of the tree?
