

Sentence Building with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use fronted adverbials to start sentences.

Max the Monkey loves to organise his maths puzzles. Help him sort the sentence parts! Look at the fronted adverbial (the time or place part) and match it to the main sentence. Write the full sentence on the line. Remember to use a comma after the adverbial part.

Word bank: Quietly · In the forest · Yesterday · Suddenly · Before school

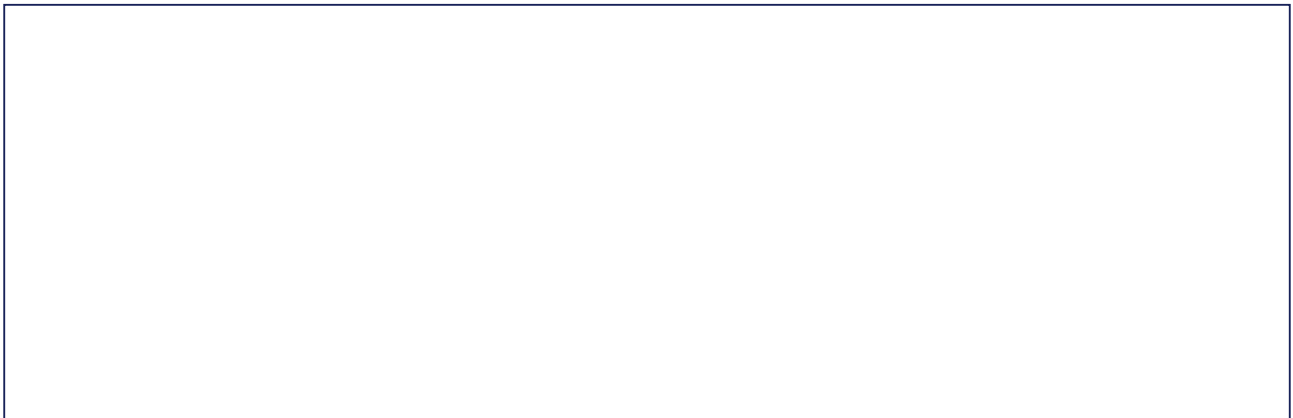
1. 1. Use the word 'Yesterday' to start this sentence: I went to the park. (Start with: Yesterday, ...) (2 marks)

2. 2. Use the word 'Quietly' to start this sentence: Max ate a banana. (Start with: Quietly, ...) (2 marks)

3. 3. Use the phrase 'In the forest' to start this sentence: The monkeys played tag. (Start with: In the forest, ...) (2 marks)

4. 4. Use the word 'Suddenly' to start this sentence: The rain began to fall. (Start with: Suddenly, ...) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey playing in a forest. Make sure he looks happy!



Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence about Max starting with the phrase 'After lunch'?
