

Create Your Own Story World with Pip

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to plan and illustrate a setting for a story.

Follow the steps below to draw your own story setting. Think about where your story takes place. Use the word bank to add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large, imaginative scene in a rectangular frame. Include a clear background (like a forest or building), one central character, and one secret object. Use bright colours and clear outlines. Add labels to your drawing using the provided word bank.



Label words: mysterious · bright · ancient · hidden · adventure · pathway · shadows · glowing

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the setting of your story. Is it a forest, a castle, or a faraway island? Draw your main scene in the box provided.
2. Step 2: Add one character to your drawing. Who is having an adventure there?
3. Step 3: Choose two words from the word bank to describe your setting. Write them near your drawing.
4. Step 4: Draw one 'hidden' object in your scene that tells us a secret about your story.
