

Pip's Word Garden: A Vocabulary Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To use descriptive vocabulary to enhance a drawing and build a word bank for creative writing.

Follow the steps below to create a scene for Pip the caterpillar. Use the word bank to add labels to your drawing. If you need help starting your sentences, use the sentence starters provided.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly garden scene. In the centre, draw Pip the caterpillar sitting on a big leaf. Include at least three different types of flowers around Pip. Use bright colours. Once you have finished your drawing, draw arrows to your items and add labels using the words from the word bank.



Label words: vibrant · shimmering · enormous · delicate · sunny · whispering

Steps:

1. Pip is looking at a flower. Write a sentence to describe the flower using one word from the word bank. Start with: The flower is...
2. Where is Pip sitting? Write a sentence about Pip's spot. Start with: Pip is sitting on...
3. Pick one word from the word bank and explain why you chose it for your drawing.
4. Label your drawing with two adjectives from the word bank that describe the plants.
