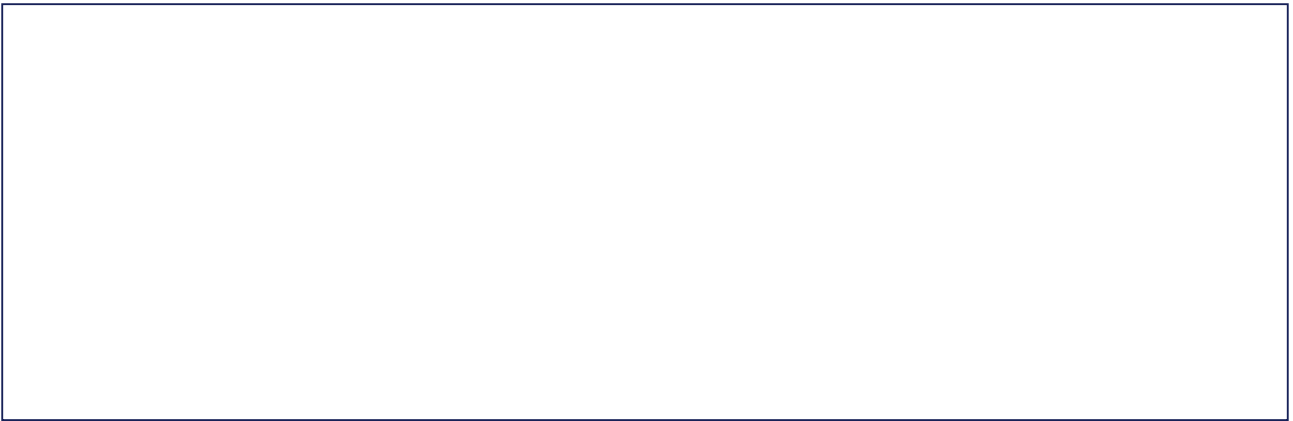
4. 4. If you were going to dress up as a book character, who would you choose and why? (3 marks) (3 marks)
