

World Book Day: My Favourite Story Scene

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to label a drawing of a favourite book scene.

Today, we are celebrating World Book Day! Think of a story you love. Draw a scene from that story in the box below. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing with interesting details.

Draw: Draw a large scene in the middle of the page. Use bright colours. Include your main character and the place where the story happens. Add small arrows pointing to items in your drawing to label them using the word bank.



Label words: character · setting · adventure · magic · colourful · exciting · background · foreground

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw your favourite character in the middle of the box. Write the character's name here:
2. Step 2: Draw the setting around them. Where is your character? Write the setting here:
3. Step 3: Label three things in your drawing (e.g., 'the big tree' or 'the shiny sword'). Write your labels below:
4. Step 4: Write one sentence to describe what is happening in your drawing. Start with: My character is...
