

Exploring Different Climates with Finn the Dolphin

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key features of different climate zones around the world.

Finn the Dolphin is travelling the globe! Use the drawing space to create two different climate scenes. Follow the steps below to label your drawings correctly.

Draw: Split your page in half. On the left side, draw a bright, colourful tropical rainforest with tall trees and lots of rain. On the right side, draw a cold polar landscape with snow, ice, and a clear blue sky. Use bright colours for the tropical side and cool, pale colours for the polar side.



Label words: Tropical · Polar · Equator · Ice cap · Rainforest · Temperature

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a very hot, green rainforest near the Equator. Label the 'Rainforest'.
2. Step 2: Draw a very cold, white place near the top of the world. Label the 'Ice cap'.
3. Step 3: Which climate is closer to the Equator, the hot one or the cold one?
4. Step 4: Draw a sun near your tropical scene to show it is warm there.
