- Weather changes every day, but climate tells us what the weather is usually like in a specific part of the world.
- The Tropical zone is found near the Equator. It is hot and rainy all year round.
- The Polar zone is found at the North and South Poles. It is very cold and often covered in ice.
- The Temperate zone has four distinct seasons: spring, summer, autumn, and winter. The UK is in this zone.
- Climate affects how people live, what clothes they wear, and which plants can grow in their area.

Did you know? Did you know? Weather is what is happening outside your window right now, like rain or sunshine. Climate is the pattern of weather in a place over a very long time, usually 30 years or more!
